School Board Update:

NOTES AND INFORMATION FROM THE JUNE 19, 2012 REGULAR BOARD MEETING

The meeting convened at 7:00 p.m. and at approximately 8:10 p.m. was adjourned. There were no public comments or questions.

Administrative and Board Committee Reports:

Mr. Pawlik informed the board that there has been no new progress on the Pennsylvania State Budget. Currently, the Governor is in private negotiations with Republican legislators to develop the final framework for the budget.

The final information from the class of 2012 was very positive. Approximately 75% of our students will attend either a 2 or 4-year college. Our graduating seniors received over \$900,000 of awards and scholarships.

The final online grading report for the year is completed. There were 19,698 log-ins to access the system. Once logged in, 4480 people viewed assignments, 3095 viewed student attendance and 19832 viewed student grades. The system has been very positive and effective.

Through a grant from Muncy Bank & Trust, we were able to order a video production studio to be put into action next year. We are currently planning to use the system for wide and varied projects.

The McClure Company made a presentation to the board to implement a new Guaranteed Energy Savings Program. Included in the proposal is an upgrade to lighting at Ashkar Elementary as well as the Jr./Sr. High School. Over a 20-year period, the net savings to the district will be over \$200,000. Also included in the project is the replacement of the grease trap in the Ferrell cafeteria.
