School Board Update:

NOTES AND INFORMATION FROM THE September 25, 2012 REGULAR BOARD MEETING

The meeting convened at 7:00 p.m. and at approximately 7:45 p.m. was adjourned. There were no questions or comments.

Mr. Randy Eddinger was sworn in as a new East Lycoming Board Member to replace Renee Laychur.

Administrative and Board Committee Reports:

During the Administrative reports, it was shared with the board that the first level of paperwork has been submitted to the State of Pennsylvania to create our “Spartan Foundation.” We are hoping that the application will be approved in the next two weeks. Once the state approves our initial application, we will need to file for an EIN number and apply to the IRS for the final 501 (c) 3 status.

The names of the newest members of the Athletic Hall of Fame were shared with all in attendance. New inductees include Harry Fry, Lee Hall and Michael Fought.

Information was also provided outlining Governor Corbett’s desire to achieve higher attendance in parochial schools. The Governor recently attended a rally and spoke in favor of the plan introduced by the Diocese of Philadelphia to increase enrollment in parochial schools in the Philadelphia Area by twenty-five percent. The Governor’s goal is to use money diverted from the state budget to pay for this increase in enrollment.

Prior to the meeting, a question was asked about the Muncy Youth Football Association using our fields. There has been no communication between the Muncy League and the ELSD administration about this issue and we have not agreed to do so.

Board Policy:

Board Policies 103, 123 and 701 were approved for the first reading. These policies need to be modified in order to reflect changes in Title IX legislation. The new legislation will require a much deeper level of financial and programmatic reporting to the state.
