## *School Board Update:*

### *NOTES AND INFORMATION FROM THE October 11, 2011 REGULAR BOARD MEETING*

The meeting convened at 7:00 pm and at approximately 7:40 p.m. was adjourned. There were no comments from members of the audience.

#### **Administrative and Board Committee Reports:**

Mr. Pawlik reported on the cost of cyber schools and the effectiveness of the schools in question. This year the ELSD will spend over \$400,000 to educate resident students in Pennsylvania cyber schools.

The board was also informed of the hard work that Hughesville Jr./Sr. High teachers are doing to incorporate the CDT testing system in grades 7-12. Mr. Coburn will be providing a more detailed description of the CDT system to the Board in November.

The board was presented with an award for our “Green Schools” initiative from the nonprofit organization PennFuture. This group recognized individuals, businesses and nonprofit organizations that foster the use of “green power” and promote environmentally friendly practices.

Mrs. Wylie reported on the in-service activities of October 10<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Michael reported that the Athletic Committee discussed the potential of current legislation to mandate concussion training for all district coaches.
