*Graduate of Hughesville High School, James earned his B.S. at the United States Military Academy, M.S. at the Georgia Institute of Technology and completed the Executive Development Program at Cornell University and the Army War College. He served twenty-six years in the Army with two combat tours in Vietnam and four years in Germany. He commanded a nuclear capable artillery unit in Germany, as well as serving four years in the Pentagon where he retired as a Colonel. He served as Chief of Staff of the Selective Service System and the Veterans Administration, where he directed the daily operations of over 240,000 personnel with a budget of \$36 billion. He was the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army and a Vice President with Lockheed Martin Corporation directing a \$300 million contract. He led a Department of Defense Joint Task Force in President Clinton's Reinventing Government initiative and provided Department of Defense oversight for rebuilding Kuwait City after the Gulf War and the disaster relief operations after Hurricane Andrew and the Northridge earthquake. Awards include the Legion of Merit (3), Bronze Star (4) and Distinguished Service Awards from the Selective Service System and the Veterans Administration.*
